Both Rate Disk and the Product Guidelines Manual contain the following changes:

AIA Assignment Fee Increase:

AIA's new assignment fee is now \$750 per case, effective July 1, 2011. Cases locked-in before July 1, 2011, that also meet the expected funding, will be charged a \$500 assignment fee.

Revised AIA Assignment Request Form:

This form is now only required on AIA Employment Cases.

AIA Address Change:

Fax Number Change:

Reports and forms have been updated to reflect the new fax number of 866-676-2138 for our Sales team.

Revised Premium Transmittal Forms:

Premium Transmittal Forms are required on all cases.

The Product Guidelines Manual contains the following changes (in addition to the changes listed above):

Direct Deposit and Address Change Forms:

New claimant Direct Deposit and Change of Address forms are included.

Updated Business Requirements:

The following sections contain updated business requirements:

Releasing First Payments – Proof of birth is required if life contingent payments are included on the Application;

Proof of Age – Proof of age is required if the payee is a non-US citizen; and

Secured Creditor – Secured Creditor language is no longer required in the Settlement Agreement & Release; however, when included this language must be the Allstate approved language.
